<i>Metro</i> Joe Conzemius,	OUT OF BOUNDS:	Course boundaries are defined by the following: White stake or lines and property fences. Inside edge of Pavement/Curbing for roads or parking lot bordering the course. No free relief from boundary markings.					
Interlachen Country Club	PENALTY AREAS:	Penalty Areas are defined by either <i>RED</i> or <i>YELLOW</i> stakes and/or lines. When both stakes and lines are used to mark a Penalty Area, the stakes <i>identify</i> while the lines <i>define</i> the Penalty Area.					
Shannon Klick, Minnesota Valley Country Club	DROPPING ZONE: Three dropping zones have been added 1) relief from obstruction between #7 green and #8 teeing area, 2) fence behind #15 green, 3) OB fence (ball unplayable, not free relief), block wall, cart path behind #18 green. If taking any relief option, the player must choose the closer dropping zone.						
<i>Northeast</i> Mike Stone,	GROUND UNDER	 In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are <i>ground under repair</i>: Model Local Rule F-7 – Ball in sod seams of newly sodded areas – <i>lie of ball & area of intended swing only</i> Bunker Rule – If a ball lies in a damaged area (regardless of cause) in a bunker, relief may be taken without penalty in accordance with Rule 16.1c as long as <i>relief is taken within the bunker</i> and within one club length of the nearest point of complete relief, no nearer the hole and the ball must be dropped. This applies to lie of ball and area of intended swing. NOTE: In the unlikely event there is no relief available without going closer to the hole, the player may go to the <u>nearest point of relief</u> and drop at that point, even if nearer the hole. Hole #10 – A ball hit to the left of #10 fairway in an area where trees have been removed may be played as in ground under repair. Free relief may be taken to the nearest point of relief, no closer, no penalty (the ball must be dropped).
