Local Rules and Information Sheet

RULES OF PLAY: All play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the MGA Terms of Competition, MGA Model Local Rules, Notice to Competitors, Entry Blank, COVID-19 Special Local Rules and the following local rules.

TEES: All competitors will play from the **MGA TEE MARKERS** (6,693 Yards).

FORMAT: 36 Holes, stroke play, with the lowest scorer being declared the champion. The Championship may be shortened or a cut made if weather conditions do not allow for the entire Championship to be played.

PLAYOFFS: A tie for the Championship will be decided by a playoff on the course immediately following completion of the final round. Holes: TBD. Any playoff for second or third place will end in a tie for trophies and awards.

PRACTICE PUTTING: Is **NOT** permitted on the putting green of the hole last played per MGA Policy. **Penalty:** Two strokes at the next hole.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following are ground under repair:
(1) All cultivated flower and shrubbery beds – **mandatory relief.**

OBSTRUCTIONS: The following conditions are in effect:

- (1) "Bagged Trees": Only the bags are immovable obstructions. If the bag interferes with stance, area of intended swing or the lie of the ball, the player is entitled to free relief. However, there is no free relief granted if interference by the tree itself.
- (2) "Wrapped Trees": NO relief for interference from a wrapped tree.

PENALTY AREAS: Penalty Areas are defined by lines and identified by stakes.

DROPPING ZONES: Local Rule E-1.1: There are no dropping zones in use for the championship.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by white stakes and/or white lines.

PACE OF PLAY: The Pace of Play Policy published on the Championship website.

POSTING OF SCORES: The MGA *will be* posting scores to GHIN for handicap purposes.

RULES COMMITTEE: Bob Boldus and any MGA Rules Official.

STARTING TIMES: 1st round starting times are decided by random draw. 2nd round starting times will be decided by 1st round scores, with the leaders going out last in the afternoon wave. Play will be starting on holes #1 and #10. Players will be assigned either a morning or afternoon starting time.

TUESDAY STARTING TIMES: Starting times will be announced approximately an hour after play is concluded for day one. Please check www.mngolf.org for Day Two's starting times. A link will be placed on the Championship webpage to the Starting Times for Day Two. A text message and email will be sent out to participants. Please check with event staff to ensure correct information is included in your event profile.
