

Local Rules

MGA Women's Amateur Championship July 27-29, 2022 Rochester Golf & CC

Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf, MGA Local Rules and conditions, and this notice.

- Tee markers:** There are two sets of tees for this Championship. Play is from the **White** MGA tee markers for the championship flight and from the **Red** MGA tee markers for players in all other flights.
- Yardage Markers:** Most sprinkler heads are marked.
- Hole Locations:** Refer to hole location sheet.
- Out of Bounds:** Defined by white stakes, white lines, the inside edge of any curb, and the brick wall behind the first tee. Any ball crossing the parking lot or road on holes #7 and #9 and then coming to rest on another part of the course is considered OB.
- Red Penalty Area Ground Under Repair:** 17th hole
White lined areas.
- Obstructions:** Any flower bed or wood chip area that is completely encircled by a cart path should be treated as part of the cart path.
- Rest Areas:** 4th tee, 6th green, 15th tee, and 17th tee and the halfway house on 10th tee.
- Drinking Water:** 5th tee, 14th tee, halfway house on 10th tee, 1st tee.
- Decisions On Ties:** In the event of a tie for championship flight, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff starting on hole #1 and if still tied, #18 and continuing until a winner is determined. All other flights according to the USGA method of settling ties. See page 403 of the 'Official Guide to the Rules of Golf'. Last 9 holes are considered 10-18 no matter what hole you started on.

Severe Weather Course Evacuation Plan

- Signals**
- One (1)** long blast = Discontinue Play *immediately*
 - Two (2)** short blasts = Resume play
 - Three (3)** short blasts = Discontinue for non-dangerous situation

In the event of severe weather, go to the clubhouse or the maintenance building near the 7th tee. If a player believes she is in danger from lightning, she may discontinue play *without* permission from the Committee but must report to the Committee as soon as possible (Rule 5.7).
