	TEES:	All play will be from the <i>Blue</i> tees (approx.: 6,625 yards).
Edina Country Club/ Woodhill Country Club	SPOTS:	Qualifiers: 11 Alternates: 3
Vice President Paul Meierant, The Playas Golf Club	TIES:	In the event of a tie for the last qualifying spot and/or the alternate spot, an announcement will be made as to the playoff procedure. Options may include an <i>on-course</i> playoff, scorecard playoff, or deciding by lot.
	RULES:	The <i>Rules of Golf</i> , the <i>MGA Terms of Competition, Pace of Play Policy,</i> and the following local rules govern play. NOTE: Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local scorecard.

The MGA reserves the right to shorten the qualifying to 9 holes if, for any reason, the full 18 holes cannot be completed. If this happens, results will be based on 9-hole scores with the available spots divided accordingly in the event of a two-tee start.

Paper scorecards will not be provided to players. Players should review the printed and video educational information posted on the qualifying webpage to prepare in advance for this process. Also, players should make sure their mobile devices are fully charged prior to beginning play. After completing your final hole, all players and their markers should go to the Scoring Area immediately to certify their

Inside edge of Pavement/Curbing for roads or parking lot bordering the course. MLR A-5 is in effect if a ball goes out of bounds and comes to rest on another part of the golf course.
Jenny Malek, Highland National Golf Club	PENALTY AREAS:	Penalty Areas are defined by either RED or YELLOW stakes and/or lines. When both stakes and lines are used to mark a Penalty Area, the stakes <i>identify</i> while the lines <i>define</i> the

	OBSTRUCTIONS:	All <i>artificially surfaced</i> roads and paths including gravel and rock surfaced paths and roads and reasonable extensions thereof including their artificial borders. Buildings, sprinkler heads, vehicles, stakes, player equipment, signposts, benches, walls, boulders, and fences (not defining boundaries) are either Moveable or Immovable Obstructions.
	BOULDERS:	Large rock boulders around the course are part of the course. Free relief is not given.
