Local Rules & Information

All play will be from the *Maroon* tees (approx.: 6,259 yards). **Oualifiers:** 11 **Alternates:** 

In the event of a tie for the last qualifying spot and/or the alternate spot, an announcement will be made as

to the playoff procedure. Options may include an *on-course* playoff, scorecard playoff, or deciding by lot. The Rules of Golf, the MGA Terms of Competition, Pace of Play Policy, and the following local rules govern

play. NOTE: Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local scorecard.

Two 9-hole rounds, stroke play. The MGA reserves the right to shorten the qualifying to 9 holes if, for any reason, the full 18 holes cannot be completed. If this happens, results will be based on 9-hole scores with

the available spots divided accordingly in the event of a two-tee start.

The official method of scoring will be electronic by use of the Golf Genius Mobile App. Paper scorecards will not be provided to players. Players should review the printed and video educational

information posted on the qualifying webpage to prepare in advance for this process. Also, players should make sure their mobile devices are fully charged prior to beginning play. After completing your final hole, all players and their markers should go to the Scoring Area immediately to certify their

scores.

**RULES** Definition Relief Area when Taking Back on the Line Relief

TO 10.2b(1) The caddie or player must not set an object down to provide line of play assistance

NOTE: 10.2b(4) Restriction on Caddie Standing Behind Player

OUT OF Course boundaries are defined by the following: White stake or lines and property fences. Inside edge of Pavement/Curbing for roads or parking lot bordering the course. MLR A-5 is in effect if a ball goes out of **BOUNDS:** 

bounds and comes to rest on another part of the golf course.

Penalty Areas are **RED** all are defined by stakes and/or lines. **PENALTY** 

AREAS: When both stakes and lines are used to mark a Penalty Area, the stakes identify while the lines define the

Penalty Area.

**DROPPING** Local Rule E-1.1 Two Dropping Zones have been provided as additional relief options for relief from the **ZONES:** 

protective fence behind #15 Green and for the Memorial Shelter between the #3 green and the #15 green.

Use the dropping Zone closest to where your ball is located.

Radio Tower Cables on holes #13 and 14 are played the same as elevated wires. If **TOWER** 

**CABLES:** the ball strikes a cable in bounds; the shot is cancelled and it must be replayed without penalty.

**GROUND** In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are *ground under repair:* 

**UNDER** - Model Local Rule F-7 - Ball in sod seams of newly sodded areas - lie of ball and area of intended swing REPAIR:

**NO PLAY ZONE:** All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds – *mandatory relief, no penalty.* 

**OBSTRUCTIONS:** All artificially surfaced roads and paths including gravel and rock surfaced paths and roads and reasonable

extensions thereof including their artificial borders. Buildings, sprinkler heads, vehicles, stakes, player equipment, signposts, benches, walls, boulders, and fences (not defining boundaries) are either Moveable or

Immovable Obstructions.

PACE OF PLAY: The published MGA Pace of Play Policy is in effect.
