Local Rules \& Information
Players in the Players' \& Mid-Players' Divisions will play from the BLUE tees (approx. 6,761 yards). Senior Players' Division will play from the White/Gold Combo tees (approx. 6,230 yards) found on the local scorecard.

In the event of a tie for the last qualifying spot and/or the alternate spots, an announcement will be made as to the playoff procedure. Options may include an on-course playoff (preferred). If conditions do not permit an on-course playoff, a scorecard playoff may be used.
The Rules of Golf, the MGA Terms of Competition, Pace of Play Policy, and the following local rules govern play. NOTE: Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local scorecard.
Two 9 -hole rounds, stroke play. The MGA reserves the right to shorten the qualifying to 9 holes if, for any reason, the full 18 holes cannot be completed. If this happens, results will be based on 9 -hole scores with the available spots divided accordingly in the event of a two-tee start.
The official method of scoring will be electronic by use of the Golf Genius Mobile App. Paper scorecards will not be provided to players. Players should review the printed and video educational information posted on the qualifying webpage to prepare in advance for this process. Also, players should make sure their mobile devices are fully charged prior to beginning play. After completing your final hole, all players and their markers should go to the Scoring Area immediately to certify their scores.
Course boundaries are defined by the following: White stake or lines and property fences. Inside edge of Pavement/Curbing for roads (entrance road) or parking lot bordering the course.
Penalty Areas are defined by either RED or YELLOW stakes and/or lines.
When both stakes and lines are used to mark a Penalty Area or Out-of-Bounds, the stakes identify while the lines define the Penalty Area or Out-of-Bounds.
Local Rule E-1.1 Dropping Zones have been provided as additional relief options as follows:
Hole \#9: located by the pine tree nearest the cart path left of the green for a ball coming to rest in the cart staging area (free relief).
Hole \#18: located by the cart path left of the green for a ball on the cart path next to the clubhouse or with interference from the deck (free relief).
GROUND In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are ground under repair:
UNDER \#10: bunker left of the green will be played at GUR due to maintenance.
REPAIR:
NO PLAY ZONE: All cultivated flower \& shrubbery beds - mandatory relief, no penalty.
MAINTENANCE To the left side of \#2 is in play.

## AREA:

OBSTRUCTIONS: All artificially surfaced roads and paths including gravel and rock surfaced paths and roads and reasonable extensions thereof including their artificial boarders. Buildings, sprinkler heads, vehicles, stakes, player equipment, signposts, benches, walls, boulders, and fences (not defining boundaries) are either Moveable or Immovable Obstructions.
PACE OF PLAY: The published MGA Pace of Play Policy is in effect.
