	RULES:	The <i>Rules of Golf</i> , the <i>MGA Terms of Competition, Pace of Play Policy</i> and the following local rules govern play. NOTE: Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local scorecard.
	FORMAT:	Two 9-hole rounds, stroke play. The MGA reserves the right to shorten the qualifying to 9 holes if, for any reason, the full 18 holes cannot be completed. If this happens, results
		will be based on 9-hole scores with the available spots divided accordingly in the ever a two-tee start.

When both stakes and lines are used to mark a Penalty Area, the stakes <i>identify</i> while the lines <i>define</i> the Penalty Area. Model Local Rule B-2.1 has been adopted and allows for a drop on the opposite side of a red penalty area. It may be found on the MGA Terms of Competition.
<i>Northwest</i> Glen Hasselberg, The Vintage at Staples	DROPPING ZONE:	Local Rule E-1.1 There is a dropping zone for this tournament. Hole 17 for a ball that last crosses the edge of the penalty area on the green side.
<i>Southeast</i> Skip Hambright, Med City Golf Club	GROUND UNDER REPAIR:	In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are <i>ground under repair:</i> - Model Local Rule F-7 – Ball in sod seams of newly sodded areas – <i>lie of ball only</i>
Southwest Mark Loosbrock, Worthington Country Club	NO PLAY ZONE:	All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds – <i>mandatory relief</i>
West Central John Young, Balmoral Golf Course	OBSTRUCTION	S: All <i>artificially surfaced</i> roads and paths including gravel and rock surfaced paths and roads and reasonable extensions thereof including their artificial boarders. Buildings, sprinkler heads, vehicles, stakes, player equipment, signposts, benches, walls and fences (not marking boundaries) are either Moveable or Immovable Obstructions. The rock pile on Hole 16 is an integral part of the course; <i>free relief is not allowed</i> .
