Interlachen Country Club OUT OF Course boundaries are defined by the following: White stake or lines and property

fences. Inside edge of Pavement/Curbing for roads or parking lot bordering the course. If a ball **BOUNDS:** Shannon Klick,

crosses a boundary and comes to rest on another part of the golf course, the ball is still out of

bounds.

NOTE: Hole #18, near the clubhouse is painted as out of bounds near the base of the retaining wall. The entire left side of hole #13 is painted as out of bounds near the mow line. The line

defines the out of bounds.

Mike Stone. Crosswoods Golf Course **PENALTY** Penalty Areas are defined by either **RED** or **YELLOW** stakes and/or lines.

When both stakes and lines are used to mark a Penalty Area, the stakes identify while the lines AREAS: Northwest

define the Penalty Area.

Glen Hasselberg. **DROPPING** Local Rule E-1.1 There are no dropping zones in effect for this qualifier.

The Vintage at Staples ZONE:

Southeast **GROUND** In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are *ground under repair:* Skip Hambright, UNDER - Model Local Rule F-7 - Ball in sod seams of newly sodded areas - *lie of ball only*

REPAIR: Med City Golf Club

NO PLAY All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds – mandatory relief, no penalty Southwest

ZONE: Mark Loosbrock.

OBSTRUCTIONS: All artificially surfaced roads and paths including gravel and rock surfaced paths and roads and **Great Life Golf & Fitness**

reasonable extensions thereof including their artificial borders. Buildings, sprinkler heads, vehicles, stakes, player equipment, signposts, benches, walls, and fences (not defining boundaries) are either

Movable or Immovable Obstructions.
