Local Rules, Information & Hole Location Sheet

All play is governed by the Rules of Golf and as modified by the <u>MGA Tournament Players' Information</u> sheet, <u>Rules of Play and Information</u> sheet, <u>Notice to Competitors</u>, <u>Pace of Play Policy</u> sheet, Entry Form and the following local rules. Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local scorecard. Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a Local Rule or Condition is: <u>Match Play – Loss of Hole</u>.

TEE: *Players' Championship* will play from the *GREEN* MGA markers. *Women's Match Play* will play from the *BLUE* MGA markers.

FORMAT: 18 holes, match play. If the match is all square after 18 holes, the match will continue from the first hole of the match and until a winner has been determined. These extra holes are considered part of the stipulated round.

PRACTICE PUTTING: The prohibition to practice putting has been waived for the match play portion of these competitions.

PACE OF PLAY: Players are expected to play within the Pace of Play established for these Championships and posted on the respective Championship webpages.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Course boundaries are defined by the following:

- (1) White Stakes & Lines
- (2) Property Fences (Holes 5 & 6)
- (3) The inside edge of curbing for roads bordering the course. (Holes 16-18)
- (4) NOTE: A ball going out of bounds and coming to rest on another part of the course is still out of bounds.

PENALTY AREAS: When both stakes and lines are used to mark a penalty area, the stakes identify and the lines define the penalty area.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: The following areas are considered ground under repair:

- (1) Areas circled by white lines.
- (2) Sod seams of unmarked newly sodded areas lie of ball only.
- (3) All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds NO PLAY ZONES.

DROP ZONES: Drop zones have been provided as additional relief options:

- (1) Hole #2 Long left & right (for ball in the lateral water hazard)
- (2) Hole #3 Behind green (for a ball in the lateral water hazard [river])
- (3) Hole #13 Behind green (for a ball in the lateral water hazard [river])
