Local Rules & Information All players in the Players' & Mid-Players' Qualifier Divisions will play from the BLUE tees (approx. 6,585

Players': Alternates: Mid-Players': 5 **Alternates:**

Senior Players': 5 Alternates: 3

In the event of a tie for the last qualifying spot and/or the alternate spots, an announcement will be made as to the playoff procedure. Options may include an on-course playoff (preferred). If conditions do not permit an on-course playoff, a scorecard playoff may be used.

Players in the Senior Players' Division will play the *WHITE tees* (approx. 6,3671 yards). NOTE: A senior

player attempting to qualify in the Mid or Players' Division must follow the cart rules for that division.

The Rules of Golf, the MGA Terms of Competition, Pace of Play Policy, and the following local rules govern play. NOTE: Disregard any local rules printed on the local scorecard.

Two 9-hole rounds, stroke play. The MGA reserves the right to shorten the qualifying to 9 holes if, for any reason, the full 18 holes cannot be completed. If this happens, results will be based on 9-hole scores with the available spots divided accordingly in the event of a two-tee start.

The official method of scoring will be electronic by use of the Golf Genius Mobile App. Paper scorecards will not be provided to players. Players should review the printed and video educational information posted on the qualifying webpage to prepare in advance for this process. Also, players should make sure their mobile devices are fully charged prior to beginning play. After completing your final hole, all players and their markers should go to the Scoring Area immediately to certify their scores.

Course boundaries are defined by the following: White stake or lines and property fences.

Hole #16 & #17: Driving Range is out of bounds. Hole #15: Driving Range is not out of bounds. The entrance road is played as an immovable obstruction and is not a course boundary.

Penalty Areas are defined by either **RED** or **YELLOW** stakes and/or lines.

When both stakes and lines are used to mark a Penalty Area, the stakes identify while the lines define the Penalty Area. All naturalized areas, areas of water or tall grass that are unkept, are played as a red penalty area even if not marked. The mow line is used to define the edge of the penalty area if not marked.

Local Rule E-1.1 There are no dropping zones in use during the competition.

In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are ground under repair: Model Local Rule F-7 – Ball in sod seams of newly sodded areas – lie of ball and area of intended swing

only. **NO PLAY ZONE:** All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds – *mandatory relief, no penalty.*

Any practice putting green (wrong green).

OBSTRUCTIONS: All *artificially surfaced* roads and paths including gravel and rock surfaced paths and roads and reasonable extensions thereof including their artificial boarders. Buildings, sprinkler heads, vehicles, stakes, player equipment, signposts, benches, walls, boulders, and fences (not defining boundaries) are either Moveable or

Immovable Obstructions.

The published MGA Pace of Play Policy is in effect. RULES COMMITTEE: MGA Site Captain and any other MGA committee person.
