RULES OF PLAY: All play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the MGA Rules Card, Notice to Competitors, Entry Blank and the following local rules. NOTE: Disregard any local rules printed on the local scorecard.

TEES: All competitors will play from the *MGA tee markers*.

FORMAT: 36 holes, stroke play.

SCORING: As required by Rule 23.2b, "Each score must be clearly identified as the score of the individual partner who made it; if this is not done, the side is *disqualified*."

PRACTICE ON PUTTING GREEN OF HOLE LAST PLAYED: Prohibited per MGA Terms of Competition. **Penalty: Two strokes at the next hole applied to the player who committed the breach.**

OUT OF BOUNDS: Boundaries are defined by the following:

- (1) White stakes and/or white lines
- (2) Property fences

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: In addition to areas circled by white paint, the following are considered ground under repair. (NOTE: When an area of GUR is surrounded by a cart path, the entire area is to be considered as one obstruction.)

(1) All cultivated flower and shrubbery beds – *Mandatory Relief*

PENALTY AREAS: Penalty Areas are identified by stakes and/or lines. When both stakes and lines are used to mark a hazard, the stakes *identify* while the lines *define* the penalty area

DROP ZONE: A drop zone has been provided as an additional option on the following hole:

- (1) Hole #2 for a ball in the penalty area behind the green
- (2) Hole #7 for a ball in the penalty area behind the green

PACE OF PLAY: The MGA Pace of Play Policy posted on the MGA web site in advance is in effect and will be enforced. The finish time for each hole has been printed on the Official Scorecards.

CUT & STARTING TIMES FOR WEDNESDAY: Per the *Notice to Competitors*, the top **13 teams** plus ties from Monday and the top **23 teams** plus ties from Tuesday will advance to the final round on Wednesday. The leaders will go at 9:00 am off #1 tee, with the highest scoring teams that make the cut going off #10 at 10:00 am. Approximate time for the first groups will be in the 7:30 am range, depending upon how many teams make the cut. The MGA will send emails and/or text messages once the starting times have been finalized.
