Championship Information

Congratulations on making the **22nd MGA Senior Players' Championship** or the **16th MGA Mid-Players' Championship** at *Royal Golf Club* on June 13-15! We are excited to have you as part of the Championship and look forward to seeing you there. Here is some important information you need to know in advance of the event. But, if we have missed something or you have other questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.

<u>Championship Fee</u> – The Championship fee is \$85 and includes all food & beverage while you are playing at Royal. We will attempt to charge your card on file when we promote you to the Championship; however, if there are issues, you will be sent an electronic invoice from which you may pay.

<u>Championship Format</u> – The format features the "Pool Play" concept similar to the PGA TOUR's "Dell Match Play." All players will be placed into groups of four based on seeding (determined by exemption or qualifying ranks). Each group will play a "round robin" schedule for the first three rounds (Monday AM, PM and Tuesday AM). All players in the group will play together as a foursome for all three rounds of pool play. Players will earn one point for a win and one-half point for a tie. After three rounds, the player with the greatest number of points will advance to the Quarterfinal round on Tuesday PM. The Semifinal and Final rounds will be played Wednesday AM and PM, respectively.

In the event of a tie in points after three rounds, the players who are tied will playoff on the course in a stroke play, "sudden death" manner. The playoff will begin at the next hole AFTER both matches are concluded in Round 3. For example, Player A wins his match on the 13^{th} hole and finishes with 2 points. Player D wins his match on the 16^{th} hole and finishes with 2 points. A and D will have a playoff beginning on the 17^{th} hole.

<u>Seeding</u> – Players will be seeded as indicated on the Exempt Player list and then as follows. (NOTE: "Qualifying Score Differential" = score minus course rating)

- 1. Medalists from Qualifying Sites (based on qualifying score differential)
- 2. Other Qualifiers (based on qualifying score differential)

<u>Championship Pod Groupings & Starting Times (Monday & Tuesday AM)</u> -

These will be posted at NOON (12 pm) *Friday, June 10.* Any withdrawal after the time will not be filled and will result in byes.
